Location: Mount Coolum

Kondolilla National Park

Location: Flaxton

Kondalilla National Park is a beautiful protected area near Montville on Queensland's Sunshine Coast, about 100km north of Brisbane. Known for its lush rainforest, spectacular waterfalls, and excellent hiking trails, it is a popular nature getaway for tourists visiting the hinterland of the Sunshine Coast. Try out the Picnic Creek circuit – a 17-km trek that takes roughly an hour to complete.




