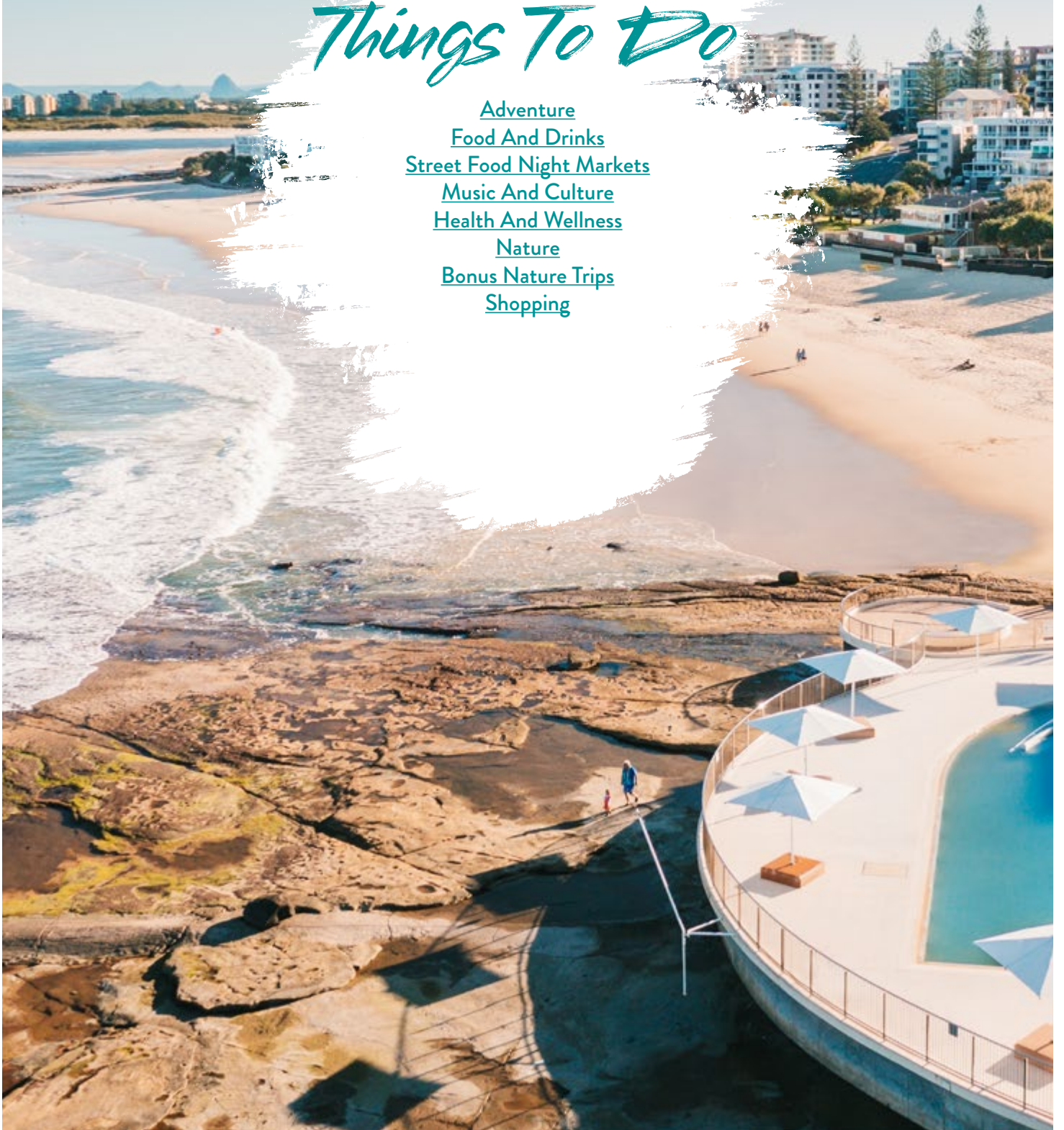

Head down to Australia's largest zip line attraction. Enjoy 70 high rope challenges and 5 zip line courses. There's plenty to keep you busy.

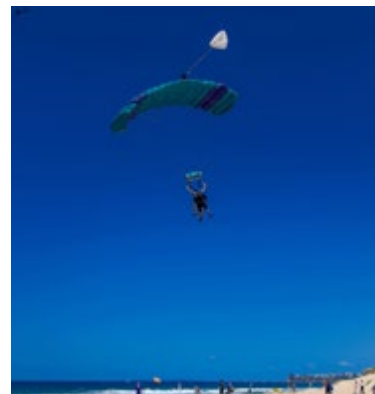

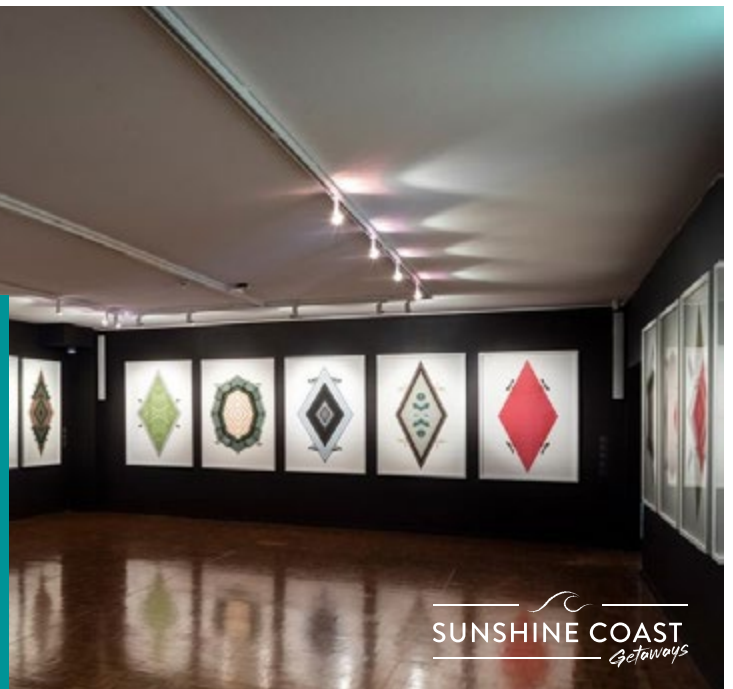


Noosa Regional Gallery

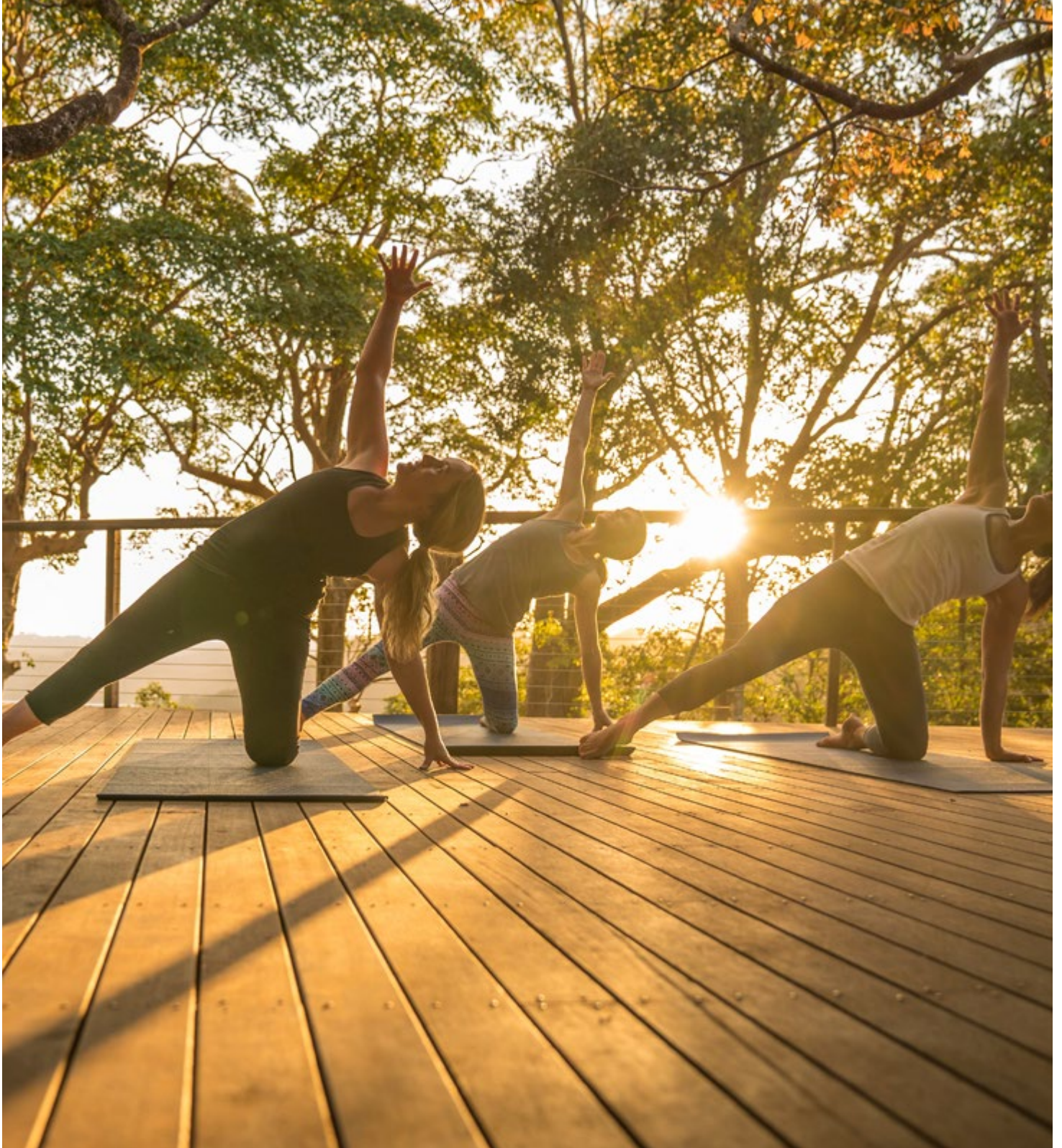

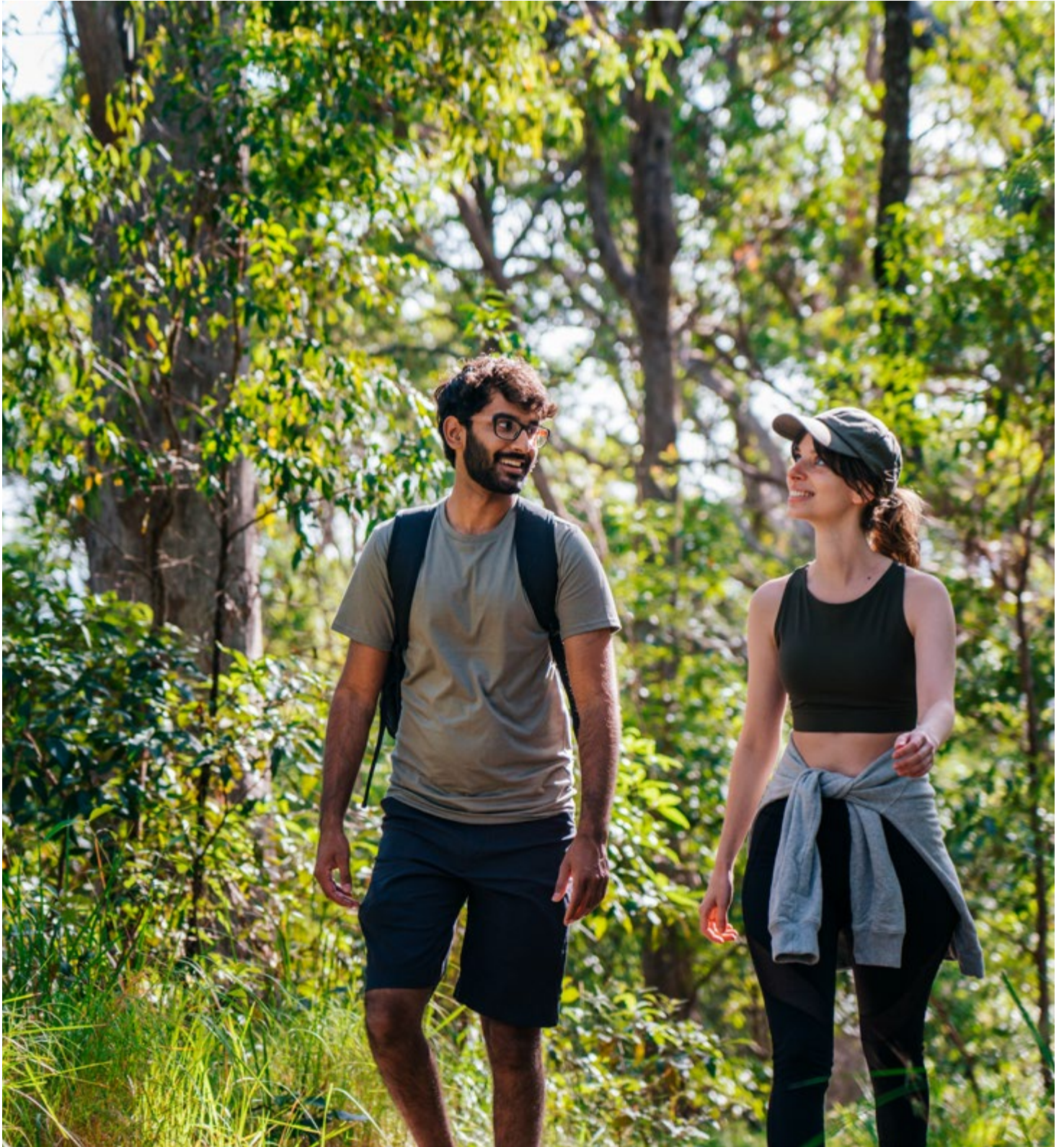
